

# German course. B1 level

**TYPE: Four-month term**

**DURATION:** 160 hours split over two four-month terms of 80 hours each\*:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Term - B1.1 (September to December)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Term - B1.2 (January to May)

**PLACE:** Vigo Campus.

**EXAM:** There is an exam to test the level at the end of the second term.

## **Aims**

Acquire intermediate knowledge of German. Aimed at people with basic, A2 level, knowledge of the language.

According to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), B1 Level has been attained when the students are capable of understanding the main points of clear texts in standard language if they deal with known subjects, which can be in work, study or leisure situations; when they know how to get by in most situations that can arise on a trip to areas where the language is used; when they can produce simple, coherent texts on topics they are familiar with or in which they have a personal interest; and when they can describe experiences, events, desires and hopes, as well as briefly justify their opinions or explain their plans.

## **Requirements**

Level B1.1: have knowledge of the language, have A2 level or take a level test.

Level B1.2: have knowledge of the language, have taken the B1.1 course or a level test.

## **Certificates**

- ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE: this requires attendance at 85% of the classes.
- LEVEL CERTIFICATE: if the final course exam is passed.
