

Portuguese course. B1 level

Two types of course are held: four-monthly and intensive.

TYPE: Four-month term

DURATION: 55 hours*:

PLACE: Campus of Vigo.

EXAM: There is a certification exam to test the level at the end of the term.

TYPE: Intensive.

DURATION: 40 hours. Courses held mainly over the summer period.

PLACE: Campus of Vigo.

EXAM: There is a certification exam to test the level at the end of the term.

Aims

Acquire an intermediate knowledge of Portuguese. Aimed at people with basic knowledge of the language.

According to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), B1 Level has been attained when the students are capable of understanding the main points of clear texts in standard language if they deal with known subjects, which can be in work, study or leisure situations; when they know how to get by in most situations that can arise on a trip to areas where the language is used; when they can produce simple, coherent texts on topics they are familiar with or in which they have a personal interest; and when they can describe experiences, events, desires and hopes, as well as briefly justify their opinions or explain their plans.

Requirements

A level test can be taken or ability can be accredited by providing a level A2 certificate obtained in the last three years.

Certificates

- ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE: this requires attendance at 85% of the classes.
- LEVEL CERTIFICATE: if the final exam is passed.
