

Portuguese course. B2 level

TYPE: Four-month term

DURATION: 55 hours*:

PLACE: Campus of Vigo.

EXAM: There is a certification exam to test the level at the end of the term.

Aims

Acquire upper-intermediate knowledge of Portuguese. Aimed at people with intermediate knowledge of the language.

According to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), B2 Level has been attained when the students are capable of understanding the main ideas of complex texts that deal with both specific, abstract subjects, and even technical ones that fall within their field of specialisation; they are also able to communicate with native speakers in a way that is fluent and natural enough for there to be no effort required by either party; they can also produce clear and detailed texts on diverse subjects and defend their own point of view on general subjects by indicating the pros and cons of the various options.

Requirements

A level test can be taken or ability can be accredited by providing a level B1 certificate obtained in the last three years.

Certificates

- ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE: this requires attendance at 85% of the classes.
- LEVEL CERTIFICATE: if the final exam is passed.
