

Portuguese course. C1 level

TYPE: Four-month term

DURATION: 55 hours*:

PLACE: Campus of Vigo.

EXAM: There is a certification exam to test the level at the end of the term.

Aims

Acquire advanced knowledge of Portuguese. Aimed at people with upper-intermediate knowledge of the language.

According to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), C1 Level has been attained when the students are capable of understanding a wide variety of extensive and relatively demanding texts, and can recognise implied meaning in them; they can also express themselves fluently and spontaneously without an obvious effort to find the right expression; they can use the language flexibly and effectively in social, academic and professional settings; they can produce clear, well-structured and detailed texts on topics of some complexity, being able to show correct usage of devices for organisation, structure and cohesion in the text.

Requirements

A level test can be taken or ability can be accredited by providing a level B2 certificate obtained in the last three years.

Certificates

- ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE: this requires attendance at 85% of the classes.
- LEVEL CERTIFICATE: if the final exam is passed.
