

## French course. A1 level

Two types of course are held: four-monthly and intensive.

**TYPE: Four-month term**

DURATION: 90 hours split over two four-month terms\*:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Term - A1.1 (45 hours)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Term - A1.2 (45 hours)

PLACE: Vigo Campus.

EXAM: There is an exam to test the level at the end of the second term.

**TYPE: Intensive.** Courses held mainly over the summer period.

DURATION: 80 hours divided into two levels:

- Level A1.1 (40 hours)
- Level A1.2 (40 hours)

PLACE: Vigo Campus.

EXAM: There is an exam to test A1.2 level at the end of the course.

### Aims

Acquire a basic knowledge of French. Aimed at people with no prior knowledge of the language.

According to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), A1 Level has been attained when the students are capable of understanding and employing frequently used daily expressions and simple phrases in order to meet immediate needs; when introducing themselves and others, asking for and giving basic personal information about their address, their belongings and the people they know; and when they can communicate in an elemental way as long as the person they are talking to speaks slowly and clearly.

### Requirements

Level A1.1: there is no level test. Direct access.

Level A1.2: basic knowledge of the language, by having taken Level A1.1 or a level test.

### Certificates

- ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE: this requires attendance at 85% of the classes.

- LEVEL CERTIFICATE: if the final course exam is passed.
