

French course. B1 level

TYPE: Four-month term

DURATION: 110 hours split over two 4-month terms of 55 hours each*:

- 1st Term - B1.1
- 2nd Term - B1.2

PLACE: Vigo Campus.

EXAM: There is an exam to test the level at the end of the second term.

Aims

Acquire intermediate knowledge of French. Aimed at people with prior knowledge of the language.

According to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), B1 Level has been attained when the students are capable of understanding the main points of clear texts in standard language if they deal with known subjects, which can be in work, study or leisure situations; when they know how to get by in most situations that can arise on a trip to areas where the language is used; when they can produce simple, coherent texts on topics they are familiar with or in which they have a personal interest; and when they can describe experiences, events, desires and hopes, as well as briefly justify their opinions or explain their plans.

Requirements

Nivel B1.1: have knowledge of the language, have A2 level or take a level test.

Nivel B1.2: have knowledge of the language, have taken the B1.1 course or a level test.

Certificates

- ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE: this requires attendance at 85% of the classes.

- LEVEL CERTIFICATE: if the final course exam is passed.
