

Methodology course for teaching Spanish as a foreign language

TYPE: Intensive

DURATION: 40 hours – Initiation.

PLACE: Vigo Campus.

Aims

This course is aimed at teachers or future teachers who wish to move their teaching career towards teaching Spanish as a Foreign Language (ELE). Students on the course will analyse different communicative techniques and procedures, both theoretical and practical, that exist in ELE methodology, and they will familiarise themselves with the skills that an ELE teacher will use in the classroom: this includes programming and planning a class, choosing which grammar to teach, presenting vocabulary and culture, assessment, selecting and creating materials, choosing resources for classroom use and incorporating new technologies, with a particular focus on social networks.

The methodology course for teaching Spanish as a foreign language has been accredited by the Instituto Cervantes since 2013.

Requirements

This course is particularly aimed at:

- Graduates or Undergraduates from Philology (or similar degrees) who are interested in a career in teaching Spanish as a foreign language both in Spain or abroad.
- Degree students.
- Teachers in primary and secondary education.
